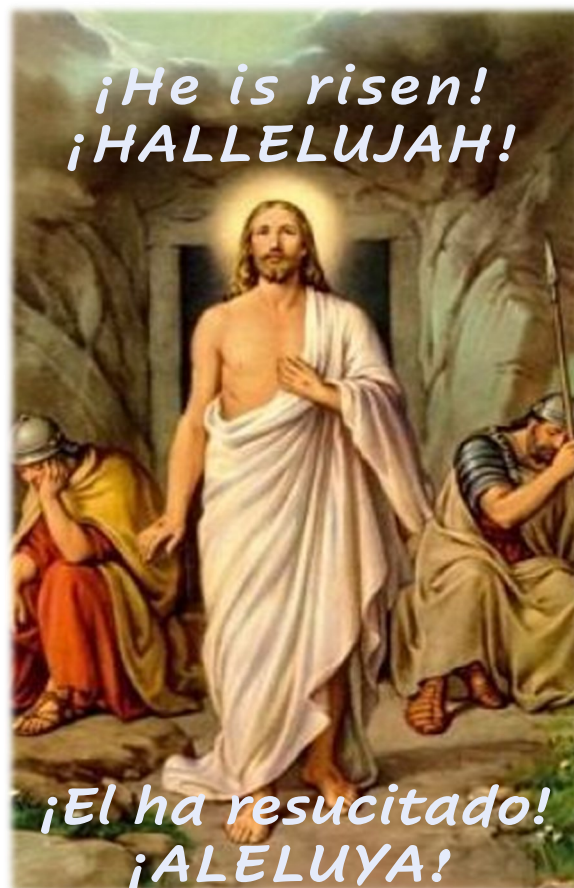

Divine Mercy Sunday



Saint Faustina of Lódź, Poland, received from our Lord in the 1930's a message of **Divine Mercy** that she was told to spread throughout the world. Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: **Jesus I trust in you.**" (Diary 47). Jesus dictated the **I promise** that the soul that will **venerate** this image will not perish. I also **promise victory** over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I myself will **defend** it as my **own glory.**" (Diary 48)

“Divine Mercy! This is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity at the dawn of the third millennium.” (St. John Paul II, *Divine Mercy Sunday Homily, 4/22/01*)

In the Divine Mercy devotion, God's love is unlimited and available to everyone! Especially the greatest sinners!

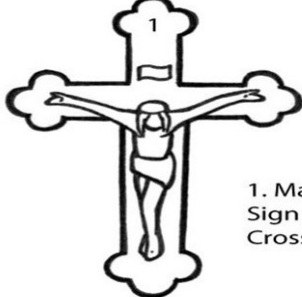

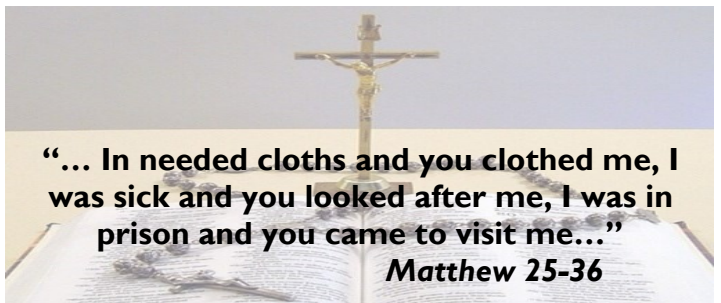

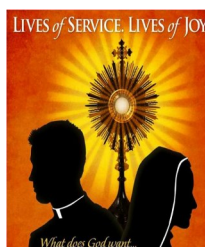

5. El Papa estableció que la Fiesta del **Señor de la Divina Misericordia** se celebrara el domingo siguiente al de Resurrección.

En la actualidad, millones de personas veneran la imagen del Señor de la Divina Misericordia en todo el mundo.

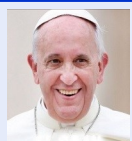


